Cigarette smoking is the greatest preventable cause of illness and death in Britain. It is associated with around 110,000 premature deaths and an estimated 50 million lost working days each year , and costs £ 610 million a year for the treatment of related diseases (for example heart disease , lung cancer and bronchitis). In addition, smoking by pregnant women is associated with low birth weight in infants.

The government is following an active health education policy aimed at reducing the level of smoking. A national campaign in England, costing £ 13.5 million a year, started in 1994. Aimed at adult smokers, particularly parents , it is being backed up by local activities to help people stop smoking. Education on the harmful effects of smoking is included in the National Curriculum for all pupils in the public schools.

Health authorities have been asked to promote non-smoking and to give help and advice to people who want to give up smoking. All tobacco advertising is, today, banned on television and radio. Other forms of promotion of tobacco products are regulated by agreements between the government and the tobacco industry.

The health warnings which appear on packets of tobacco products are governed by law. Packets of cigarettes must carry one of the following warnings :

- Smoking kills.
- Smoking causes heart disease.
- Smoking causes fatal disease.
- Smoking causes cancer.
- Smoking when pregnant harms your baby.
- Protect children : don't make them breathe your smoke.

All tobacco products must also carry the warning " smoke seriously damages your health " .
