The English Language

- 1 Various factors have contributed to impose the English language as the most suitable means for learning and vehicle for communicating.
- 2 The English language is spoken or read by the largest number of people in the world for historical, political and economic reasons.
- 3 In fact, the British who were very famous seamen navigated throughout all the seas and oceans of the world. This enabled them to settle in several remote places either by founding commercial counters or by taking over lands. This situation **allowed** the English language to be spoken in increasingly varied countries.
- 4 However, it is also true that its wide use is due to its specific qualities and characteristics. One of the most important aspects of English is the easy way with which it has taken elements from other languages. In the 5th and 6th centuries when the Anglo-Saxons first colonised England, the English language was almost pure. But it has become progressively one of the richest and most mixed languages because it has received all along history many kinds of foreign words, and adapted them all to its own character.
- 5 There is a further reason why English is so widespread. Recently, the English use has reached a pick because of the huge advance in science and technology in the USA. This obliges scientists throughout the world to master this language to acquire knowledge about the new technologies and address themselves to the majority of the international scientific community by publishing their own research results in this language.
